2022 Catholic Partnership Summit: Living Synodal Leadership: Our Call to a Unified Church

The annual Catholic Partnership Summit convenes Catholic lay, religious, and clergy leaders to help strengthen the Church to fulfill its mission and promote a co-responsible leadership culture within the Church.

The Catholic Partnership Summit is the largest event of its kind and brings together prominent leaders including the leaders of Catholic organizations, Catholic bishops and cardinals, the heads of Catholic institutions of higher education and foundations. It exemplifies the synodality and co-responsibility to which Pope Francis has called the Church and facilitates the development of actionable recommendations to address the most pressing challenges and opportunities facing the Church.

The annual Summit also includes the presentation of the **J. Donald Monan, SJ Distinguished Catholic Philanthropy Medal** to Catholic philanthropists who

have made a significant impact on the management and leadership of the Church through their generosity.

Our theme for 2022 is: **Living Synodal Leadership: Our Call to a Unified Church**. Living Synodal Leadership is a bold vision. It is how we live out our call to servant leadership and co-responsible decision-making for a healthy, thriving Church. It is actively listening to all voices, to all experiences, and embracing new, creative, and agile ways of leading in a changing world and Church. Synodal leadership employs restorative practices that move us toward healing and unity as the body of Christ. It is a willingness to regularly pause, consider, and answer the call of the Holy Spirit. It involves including those historically excluded from leadership and opening seats for them at decision-making tables. Synodal leadership offers hope, requires courage, and builds trust. It is our mission in action.

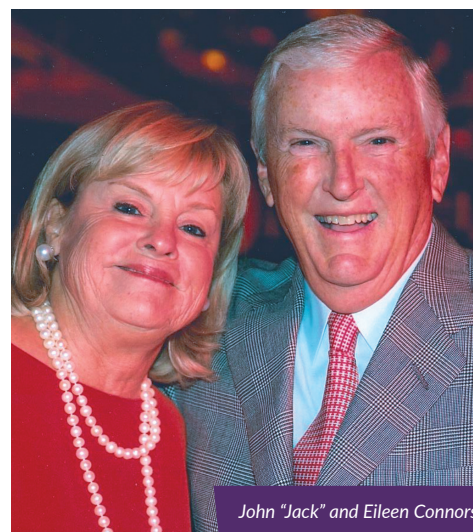
